IIASA will remain a key partner of ADRI in this enterprise and I personally will try to support the excellent work of ADRI as much as I can. Since China is also one of the most important member countries of IIASA with many established research links not only in demography but also in the environmental sciences I do hope that Shanghai University will play an important role in further strengthening the link between China and IIASA.
